Participant Responsibilities

- Arrive at the meeting place at least 15 minutes before the scheduled departure time.
- Visitors sign a waiver; members sign the member attendance sheet
- Have appropriate clothing and equipment (including a first aid kit.)
- Be prepared to spend all day in the activity if necessary.
- Inform the Activity Leader of any special medical conditions, pre-existing or arising during the Activity.
- Follow the Activity Leader.
- Stay with the group. If anyone needs to turn back, either the whole group turns back or a minimum of three people turn back.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Do not cause difficulties for yourself or for others; be aware of tree branches, hiking poles, loose rocks, *etc*.
- Avoid causing environmental damage. Leave behind nothing but footprints.
